

Welcome to the first week of the Echoes & Curves Free-motion Challenge Quilting Along. In this week's challenge we are going to learn all about the serpentine line. It's a versatile design that will give your quilt a curvy look.

About the Serpentine Line

This design is best for areas that are about 2"-4" in width, making it perfect for sashings and thinner borders. It's also great for irregularly shaped areas like wedges and diamonds as well as in between other quilting designs.

Tips for Quilting the Serpentine Line Design

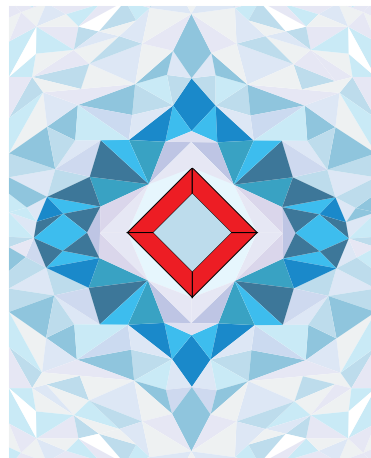
1. Look ahead of the needle. Since we are aiming for the edge of the area, it's helpful to see it approaching.
2. Focus on a smooth line, not perfection. Even if the serpentine line isn't perfect, a smooth line will still make it look great.
3. Practice drawing the design over and over again until it clicks.
