#### Echoing to Highlight Portions of Your Quilt

Echoing is an easy way to show off portions of your quilt. While you're working through this week's challenge, remember that what you echo is what you will be showing off. Try echoing one, two, or all three sides of a block. You can also combine the echo lines with other quilting designs to create beautiful texture.


#### Echoing Inspiration

#### Your Challenge:
