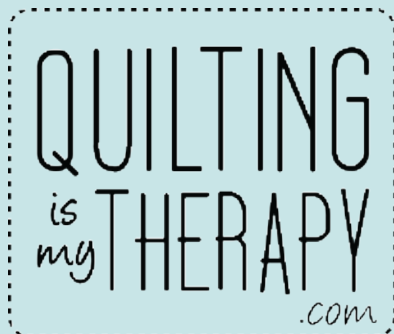
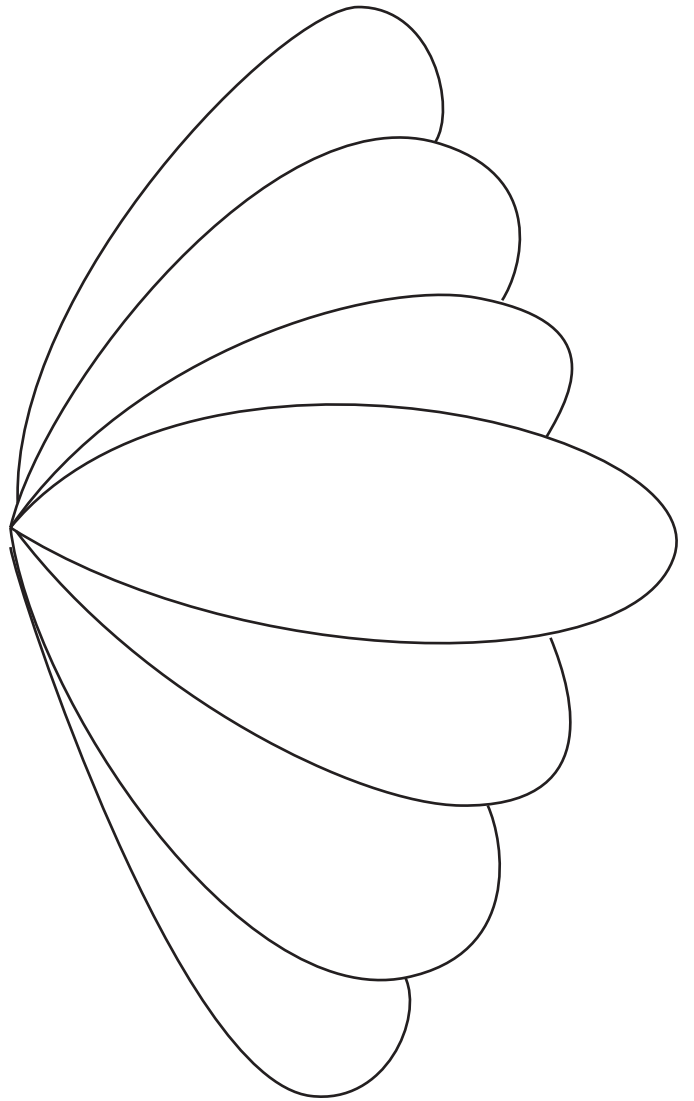


# Quilting Mini Motifs

Now that you know how to quilt feathers, learning how to quilt mini-motifs is a great way to apply your knowledge. Once you learn the mini motifs, you can apply them in different areas of your quilts.

A motif is made up of a center design, with feathers extending on both sides. Most motifs, no matter how complex looking, have the same basic formula.
